Therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant and Rice B. Pierce the said Forty six pounds twelve shillings and six pence together with lawfull interest thereon from July 1st 1782 till paid and his costs by him about his suit in that behalf expended & discharged by the payment of Twenty six pounds seventeen shillings together with interest thereon taken on 21st 1782 till paid
