said eight thousand pounds of Tobacco & his costs by him about his suit in this
behalf expended be in mercy &c But this judgment except the costs is to
be discharged by the payment of four thousand eighty nine pounds of Tobacco
with interest thereon to be computed after the rate of 5 p c p annum from 7th of
Jan 1781 till payment

the said defendant the said sum of fifty eight pounds with his costs by
him about his suit in this behalf expended to be paid of the goods & chattels
of the testator in the hands of the said William Blunt & Mary his wife to be
administered But this judgment except the costs is to be discharged by the
payment of Twenty nine pounds Virginia money with interest thereon from
the 12th day of August 1773 till payment

On the motion of Wm Dayel a witness for Micajah Griffen Esq: &c of Benjamin
Griffen against Richard Dayel it is ordered that the s^d Griffen pay him fifty pounds
of Tobacco for two days attendance on this Court according to Law
