The persons appointed to lett the repairs of the bridge over Collins old mill made the report in these words "In obedience to the within order we the subscribers did lett the repairs of the within mentioned bridge to Wm Butts for fifteen pounds we have also viewed the said repairs & find them finished according to bargain - whereupon we advise that the treasurer of this county pay the undertaker fifteen pounds for the same

An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of Liddell Turner was this day returned and ordered to be recorded

An Indenture of feoffment between Benjamin Deloach & Ann his wife of the one part and Boaz Sporn Summerville of the other part was acknowledged by the said Benjamin Deloach & Ann his wife she being first privately examined as the law directs and order'd to be recorded

A report made pursuant to the last will & testament of Esq^r. Lundy Esq^r & at the request of the legat^{ies} was this returned by Wm Blunt Jr^r, Rogers & Timothy Pope Gentlemen in these words "

An indenture of feoffment between Jeremiah Ellis & Ann his wife of the one part and James Abrahams of the other part was proved as to the S^r Jeremiah by the oath of Wm Newsum one of the witnesses thereto & having been before proved by the oaths of two other witnesses acknowledged by Ann the wife of the S^r Jeremiah who was first privately examined as the law directs is order'd to be recorded

An Indenture of feoffment between Hardy Harris of the one part and Moses Johnson of the other part was proved by the oath of Lucy James & having been before proved by the oath of two other witnesses is order'd to be recorded

The last will & testament of Joshua Wood was presented in Court by Sarah Wood & Benj^a Wood the execs therein named proved by the oaths of John Bond & John Cobb two of the witnesses thereto and order'd to be recorded and on the motion of the S^r Sarah & Benjamin who made oath according to Law calificate is granted them for obtaining a probat^{ion} thereof in due form giving security whereupon the said Sarah & Benj^a entered into & acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five thousand pounds with the Sheriff & one other Esq^r (as their due & lawful administrators of the estate
