The persons appointed to let the repairs of the bridge over Collins old mill made up apart in these words "In consideration to the within order we the subscribers did let the repairs of the within mentioned bridge to Wm Butts for fifteen pounds where also we will the said repairs of said Ram finished according to bargain - Whom further bound that the treasurer of this county pay the undertaker fifteen pounds for the same

An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of Littleton Turner was this day returned and ordered to be recorded

An Indenture of Leasement between Benjamin Delarach & Ann his wife of the one part and Boaz Green Summerville of the other part was acknowledged by the said Benjamin Delarach & Ann his wife she being first duly examined as the law directs and order'd to be recorded

A receipt made pursuant to the last will & testament of Edw^d Lundy deceased at the request of the legatees was this return'd by Wm Blunt Jr. Rogers & Timothy Pugh Gentlemen in these words "

An indenture of judgment between Jeremiah Ellis & Ann his wife of the one part and James Atherton of the other part was proved as to the S. Jeremiah by the oath of Wm Newsum one of the witnesses thereto & having been before proved by the oaths of two other witnesses acknowledged by Ann the wife of the defendant who was first duly examined as the law directs is order'd to be recorded

An Indenture of Leasement between Hardy Harris of the one part and Moses Johnson of the other part was proved by the oath of Lucy James & having been before proved by the oaths of two other witnesses is order'd to be recorded

The last will & testament of Joshua Wood was presented in Court by Sarah Wood & Benj^a Wood the executors therein named proved by the oaths of John Bond & John Cobb two of the witnesses thereto and order'd to be recorded and on the motion of the S. Sarah & Benjamin who made oath according to Law certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security whereupon the said Sarah & Benj^a Wood into & at their request their bond in the penalty of four thousand pounds (with double costs and other common security) for their due & faithful administration of the estate in the execution and performance of his will
