for twenty four thousand pounds (Virginia currency of 1781) the debt in
the declaration mentioned Therefore it is considered by the court that the
plaintiff recovers against the said defendant the afores^d sum of twenty
four thousand pounds with his costs by him about his suit in this
behalf expended & to be in money &c

except the costs is to be discharged by the payment of twelve thousand
pounds (which is to be reduced at the rate of 250 for one as decreed by the
act of assembly & a rule of this Court) and interest thereon to be computed after the
