

plaintiff's action to be just Therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant Two thousand pounds of Tobacco the sum mentioned with his costs by him about his suit in this behalf of the plaintiff to be in money due But this judgment except the costs is to be discharged by the payment of One thousand pounds of Crop tobacco inspected at Southwark the pitch landing with interest thereon from the 9th day of January 1782 till paid to be computed after the rate of 5% per centum per annum

Upon the petition of Wm Richardson & m^r & m^r of Flood Nicolson & co against Thomas Adams for Five hundred pounds of inspected tobacco due by bond This day came the action & the plaintiff by his attorney as the defendant in his proper person who confessed the allegation of the plaintiff's petition to be true Therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against him the afores^d Five hundred pounds of inspected Tobacco and his costs by him in this behalf expended But this judgment except the costs is to be discharged by the payment of Two hundred & fifty pounds of Crop tobacco and interest thereon after the rate of 5% per centum from the 20th day of March 1782 till payment
