This day came the said the plaintiff by his attorney as the defendant in his proper person who confessed the allegation of the plaintiff's petition to be true. Therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against him the said five hundred pounds of inspected Tobacco and his costs by him in this behalf expended. But this judgment except the costs is to be discharged by the payment of Two hundred & fifty pounds of Crop tobacco and interest thereon after the rate of 5 p Centum Annuum from the 20th day of March 1782 till payment.
