The prisoner was brought to the bar by the sheriff of this County to whose custody he was heretofore committed ~~and~~ charged with the fact afores^d to which he pleads not guilty - Whereupon the said Elizabeth Vick & sundry other witnesses were examined and the prisoner heard in his own defence. On consideration whereof it is the opinion of the Court that he is guilty of the fact charged against him. Therefore the Court gives sentence that the prisoner shall be castrated for the said offence. And it is ordered that the Sheriff see the sentence of the Court put into execution within days from this time & that he employ some skilful surgeon to perform the operation if one can be procured. If not that he employ some other person who in his opinion is most skilful - And that the prisoner thereafter be discharged.
