

against the said defendants the slaves afores^t to wit Simon and Oliver if to be had of not £150 the price of Simon and £150 or the price of Oliver together with her damages aforesaid in form aforesaid offered and her costs by her about her suit in this behalf expensed and the d^r defendants in mercy - From which judgment the defendants pray an Appeal to the day of the next General Court to be held in the city of Richmond which is granted on their giving bond and security &c

Petition that John Simmons sen^r Timothy Thorpe Benjamin Lewis & Benjamin Bell or any three of them lett the building a bridge over the river Nottoway near the mouth of the Opossum branch below Miles Farrys being the place reported most convenient by persons appointed to view the same &c

An indenture of peffment between Thomas Taylor and Martha his wife of the one part and Nicholas Brown of the other part was acknowledged by the said Thomas Taylor and Martha his wife she being first privily examined at the law courts and ordered to be recorded

An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of Joseph Simmons due was this day returned and ordered to be recorded

Mary Jarrell widow and relat of Benjamin Jarrell died Ann Jarrell and Elizabeth Jarrell infant children of said Benj^a Jarrell by Alridge Jones Jr their next friend - plts In Chancery against Alridge Jones wife of Benj^a Jarrell died and William Jarrell an infant &c by the rev^r Henry Mr^r Binger his guardian deft

The persons appointed to assign and set apart the dñe of the complainant Mary Jarrell in the lands and slaves of Benjamin Jarrell due & to make division of the remaining slaves between the complainants Ann & Elizabeth and the defendant William this day made their report in the following words "to wit" Pursuant to the within order so the subscribers have allotted and shaped the dñe of the widow the lands wherof Benj^a Jarrell propos'd of To wit begin at a live oak on the side of the Indian branch in the mouth of a small branch up the said branch to Taylors line along the said Taylors line to Guy's road to Barham line then along Barhams line to the Indian branch down S. branch to the beginning supposed to be 250 acres also have allotted and set apart the following negroes "for the dñe of Benj^a, Tom, Abel, Hagar, Chung Sam Duke and Maria likewise have divided the remaining part of the negroes as follows Elizabeth & Alice to have Aggy, Pratt, Sarah, Lydia, Jacob, Kate, George & Amy - Ann Jarrell to have Lucy Lewis Venus Patience Frank Beck Peter James & Nancy - William Jarrell to have Willis Bob Easter Jenny, Amos, Meg Edith & two chil^s and Ned and the said Wm Jarrell is to pay Ann Jarrell ten pounds difference in value of negroes and we do accept that the d^r widow had by her consent only the one fourth part of the slaves allotted for herself in witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands the 27th day of December 1782 sign'd Tho^r C. Conner Arthur Foster Benj^a Lewis Wherupon the court order that the said report be made the decree of this court the final between parties which is done according to law
