 ported and ordered to be recorded

+ Sally Barker orphan of William Barker decd. came into Court and chose Jo-  
 seph Marks her guardian. Whereupon the said Joseph Marks with Richard  
 Marks his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of  
 Two hundred and fifty pounds for securing the said orphans estate and in-  
 demnifying the Court.

David Barker orphan of William Barker decd. came into Court and chose Ri-  
 chard Marks his guardian and the same Richard Marks is by the Court appointed  
 guardian to Abner Barker another orphan of the said William Barker decd.  
 Whereupon the said Richard Marks with Joseph Marks and John M. Hill his secu-  
 rities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five hundred pounds  
 for securing the estates of the said orphans and indemnifying the Court.

Mark Nielson is by the Court appointed surveyor of the highway from Bray's store  
 to Buckhorn bridge in the room of Henry Westbrook who is discharged from that Office  
 Benjamin Kirkwood from Crafford's road to the Angelica chapel in the room of  
 Howell Vaughan, Ninrum Branch in the room of Jesse Washburn, John  
 Judkins in the room of Henry Baker, John Bayless in the room of Henry  
 Taylor, William Edwards in the room of William Weston, and Richard  
 Wallome in the room of Kerba Little and it is ordered that the said persons  
 with the male litchables in their several precincts do keep and repair the said  
 roads according to Law.
