Thomas Mason with Mark Nicolson & Randolph Newsum his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty Five thousand pounds for the said executor due & faithful administration on the estate of the S. decedent & performance of his will

Ordered that Howell Myrick Owen Myrick Jno Barham & Jno Applewhite or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the value of any personal estate of said Nicolson died & return the appraisement to the next Court

The last will and testament of Robert Lundy died having been proved by the witnesses thereto at the last court was this day sworn to by William Lundy & James Lundy the executors therein named according to Law on the motion of the said Executors a certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat in due form giving security whereupon the will is ordered to be recorded Whereupon the said Executors with John Barrow and Henry Toller their securities entered into acknowledging their bond in the penalty of Ten thousand pounds for the said ex^{rs} due & faithful administration on the estate of the decedent and performance of his will

Ordered that John Myrick Esq^r Harris Henry Morris and Denny Harris or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the value of any and personal estate of Robt Lundy died & return the appraisement to the next Court

Benjamin Blunt gentleman produced a Commission from the Governor to the High Sheriff of this County which was read, Whereupon the said Benjamin Blunt with Mark Nicolson and Wm Edwards his securities entered into acknowledging their bond to the S. Governor & his successors in the penalty of ten thousand pounds for the S. Sheriff due & faithful performance of his office and collection of the Taxes according to Law & having taken the oath of office was sworn Sheriff accordingly

Joshua Trol Daniel Butts Rich^d Edwards and Charles Bugge were on the motion of Ben^g Blunt High Sheriff sworn his undersheriffs

Ordered that the Vestrymen of Nottoway and Lakes parishes in this County lay off the same into precincts and appoint fit persons to procession the lands therein according to Law

An Indenture of bargain and sale between John Cherry and Elizabeth his wife Joseph Scott jr and Miriam Scott of the one part and J^r Boovers of the other part was proved by the oaths of Joseph Maungat Hardy Brown & Benjamin Beale the witnesses thereto as to Cherry Joseph Scott Miriam Scott & her bond by Elizabeth Cherry she being first privately examined as the law directs ordered to be recorded

An Indenture of bargain and sale between Henry Cherry & Lydia his wife of the one part and Shadrach Lewis of the other part was acknowledged by the S. Henry (as also the wife) and Lydia his wife she being first privately examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded
