On the motion of the plaintiff and by virtue of the Act of Assembly in that case made and provided the defendants having had legal notice thereof Execution is awarded the plaintiff against the S^r defendants for Eight pounds fifteen shillings and five pence and interest thereon from the 10th day of July 1783 till payment according to the condition of the bond aforesaid & the costs by him in this behalf expended

The Last Will & Testament of Nancy Atkinson was proved by the oaths of William Whitehead & Rich^d Hilsand two of the witnesses thereto & ordered to be recorded

On the motion of Henry Collins who offered sufficient reasons to the Court his negro slave is exempted from payment of his Taxes &c

On the motion of Benjamin Waller who made oath according to Law & affidavit is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of John Waller deceased giving security Whereupon the S^r Benjamin Waller with W^m Gooding & John Cox his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five hundred pounds for the S^r Benjamin's due & faithful administration on the estate of the S^r decedent

Ordered that James Butts Jun^r Pladger Charles Speer & George Edwards many three of them being just sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the value of any personal estate of John Waller deceased and return the appraisement to Court

An Indenture of settlement between John Daughtery of the one part & James Gardner of the other part with the memorandum thereon endorsed were proved by the oaths of John Lawrence William Weston and James Gardner S^r three of the witnesses thereto & ordered to be recorded
