

Ordered that Samuel Edmunds, Jesse Cooper and John Chitty sen: or any two of them examine state and settle an account current of the estate of William Day dead and make report thereof to this court.

Ordered that Charles Birdsong, Henry Taylor and Micajah Edwards or any two of them examine state and settle an account current of the estate of William Day dead and make report thereof to this court.

A deed of gift from Charles Briggs to George Briggs was acknowledged by the said Charles Briggs and ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that the sheriff of this county summon John Lankford to appear before the justices of our said court at the courthouse on the second Thursday in May next to answer a complaint lodged against him for misuse of his apprentices John Popper.

On the motion of Dempsey Cooper who made oath according to law certification granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of John Cooper dead giving security. Whereupon the said Dempsey Cooper with Simon Manly his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five hundred pounds for the said Dempsey's due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent.

Ordered that Matthew Wills, Henry Cobb, Thomas Laurence and Abraham Thackell or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves, if any, and personal estate of John Cooper dead, and return the appraisement to the next court.

Ordered that the churchwardens of the parish of Wottonway bind out Henry Coker orphan of Nathaniel Coker dead, according to law.

Henry Coker is by the court appointed guardian to William Coker orphan of Nathaniel Coker dead. Whereupon the said Henry Coker with Jonathan Coker his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Two hundred and fifty pounds for the said Henry's securing the estate of the said orphan and indemnifying this court.

Jonathan Coker is by the court appointed guardian to Jeremiah Coker orphan of Nathaniel Coker dead. Whereupon the said Jonathan Coker with Henry Coker his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Two hundred and fifty pounds for the said Jonathan's securing the estate of the said orphan and indemnifying this court.
