This day came as well the plaintiff by his attorney as the defendant in his proper person who saith that he cannot gaurisaf the plaintiffs action nor but that he doth owe the plaintiff the sum of Sixteen pounds eight shillings and two pence the debt in the declaration mentioned. Therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said Sixteen pounds eight shillings and two pence and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended and the said defendant in mercy &c. But this judgment except as to the costs is to be discharged by the payment of Eight pounds four shillings and one penny with interest thereon from till paid. Whereupon on the prayer of the plaintiff the said defendant is charged in custody of the sheriff in execution in discharge of this judgment and costs.

James Williford orphan of William Williford deed, came into court and chose Jordan Williford his guardian. Whereupon the said Jordan Williford with Mizajah Holliman his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five hundred pounds for securing the said orphan's estate and indemnifying this court.

Sarah and Mary Williford orphans of William Williford deed, came into court and chose Belah Williford their guardians. Whereupon the said Belah Williford with Jacob Turner his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five hundred pounds for securing the said orphans estates and indemnifying this court.

An indenture of bargain and sale between Matthews Vick and Sarah his wife of the one part and James Atkinson of the other part and the receipt thereon and bill of sale were acknowledged by the said Matthews Vick and continued for the said Sarah.

An account current of the estate of Richard Murfee deed, was reported by the persons formerly appointed to examine state and settle the same and ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of John Mitchell a writ for Henry Allen it is ordered that said Henry Allen pay him two hundred and seventy five pounds of tobacco, to eleven days attendance on this court according to law.
