But this judgment by a writ of scire facis and according to the Act of assembly in that case made & approved is to be settled in specie at the sale of the one for every seventy five pounds paper the contract being dated the 8th of January 1781.

This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendants being solemnly called and not appearing on the motion of the said plaintiff it is ordered that the conditional judgment obtained at the last court against the defendants & Drury Cotton security for their appearance be confirmed for Thirteen pounds twelve shillings three pence the debt in the declaration mentioned. Therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the aforesaid sum of Thirteen pounds twelve shillings & six pence & his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended & the s^d defendant in money &c. But this judgment except the costs is to be discharged by the payment of six pounds six shillings and one penny with interest thereon from the 1st day of April 1782 like paid.

Therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the aforesaid six pounds ten shillings & three pence & their costs by them at their suit in this behalf expended & the s^d debt in money &c. But this judgment except the costs is to be discharged by the payment of Three pounds five shillings & 1st penny with interest thereon from the 24th day of October 1778 like payment.

Therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant Twenty two pounds nine shillings & three pence & his costs by them at their suit in this behalf expended & the said defendant in money &c. But this judgment except the costs is to be discharged by the payment of Ten pounds with interest thereon from the 1st day of April 1782 like paid.
