Ordered that Titus Carr, Jacob Barnes, James Barnes and Samuel Maget or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves (if any) and personal estate of Jesse Whitehead decd. and return the appraisement to the next court.
