Upon the petition of Joseph Scott against Richard Clifton for one pound nine shillings and six pence and interest due by account. This day came the plaintiff by Richard Kello his attorney and the defendant being solemnly called and not appearing on the motion of the said plaintiff who proved his demand to be just by his own oath it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the aforesaid sum of one pound nine shillings and six pence together with lawful interest thereon from the 28th day of November 1776 till the 13th day of May 1784 and his costs by him in this behalf expended.

Then the petition of Joseph Scott, against Micajah Griffin executor of the last will and testament of Benjamin Griffin decd. for three pounds nineteen shillings and seven pence and interest due by account. This day, came the plaintiff by Richard Wells his attorney and the defendant being solemnly called and not appearing, on the motion of the said plaintiff who proved his demand to be just by his own oath, it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the aforesaid sum of three pounds nineteen shillings and seven pence together with lawfull interest thereon from the 25th day of June 1774 till the 15th day of May 1784 and his costs by him in this behalf expended to be levied of the goods and chattels which were of the said Benjamin Griffin decd. at the time of his death in the hands of the defendant or of the said Benjamin, if so much thereof he has in his hands, if not, then the costs to be levied of the proper goods and chattels of the defendant.

The petition of Joseph Scott against Benjamin Bulls is ordered to be dismissed.
