Ordered that the Churchwardens of the parish of Nottoway bind out Britain Williams orphan of Jacob Williams according to Law

Ordered that the Churchwardens of Stukes parish bind out Jacob & Samuel Chavis poor children according to Law

Ordered that Owen Myrick Henry Thraps and Arthur Applewhite or any two of them let the repairs of Moors bridge & make report to this Court

Ordered that the Churchwardens of the parish of Duke bind out William Pick as poor child of Ann Pick according to Law

Ordered that Ephay Clingo & Phillis Salongero to Wm Edwards be exempted from the payment of Taxes &c

On the motion of Thomas Kirby who made oath according to Law administration is granted him on the estate of Rich^d Kirby died with his will annexed whereupon he

John Wright having obtained an attachment against the estate of Henry Blunt who hath privately removed himself or so absconded that the ordinary process of the Law cannot be served upon him for a debt due from the S^r Blunt to the S^r Wright, William Archlow who has been duly summoned as a garnishee in this suit appeared & deposed that he is indebted to the defendant in the sum of twenty pounds £20 - Money due the 1st Jan^y 1785 & the other £20 on the first of Jan^y 1786 & the defendant not appearing it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant thirty pounds to be discharged by the payment of thirty pounds hereunto Mon^y at 5⁰⁰ p^{er} annum from the 11th day of July 1782 till paid also 2 1/2⁰⁰ l⁰⁰ & 1/2⁰⁰ of his l⁰⁰ by him in this behalf expended And it is ordered that the garnishee pay the amount of this judgment and costs to the plaintiff when the money in his hands becomes due &c

On the motion of Rob^t Threlk a witness for Joseph Tofflea against Charles Colby it is ordered that the said Tofflea pay him one hundred pounds of Cob⁰ for 4 days all and sundry his l⁰⁰ according to Law

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till Court in June
