- + Ordered that the Churchwardens of the parish of Nettleway send out Britain Williams orphan of Jacob Williams according to Law
- + Ordered that the churchwardens of St Luke's parish send out Jacob & Samuel Chavens poor children according to Law
- + Ordered that Owen Myrte Henry Thorpe and Arthur Applewhite or any two of them let the repairs of Moses bridge & make report to this Court
- + Ordered that the churchwardens of the parish of St Luke send out Willmwick a poor child of Ann Reeks according to Law
- + Ordered that Syphey Atlings & Phillis belonging to Wm Edwards be exempted from the payment of Tares &c
- + On the motion of Thomas Kirby who made oath according to Law administration granted him on the estate of Richd Kirby died with his will annex'd whereupon he

*John Wright having obtained an attachment against the estate of Richd Blunt who hath privately removed himself or so abeysed that the ordinary process of the law cannot be served upon him for a debt due from the S<sup>r</sup> Blunt to the S<sup>r</sup> Wright, William Ashlow who has been duly summoned as a garnisher in this suit appeared & affirmed that he is indebted to the defendant in the sum of fifty pounds £50 - whereof he paid the 1<sup>st</sup> Jan<sup>y</sup> 1785 £ the other £30 on the first of Jan<sup>y</sup> 1786 & the defendant not appearing it is considered by the Court that the Plaintiff recover against the said defendant fifty pounds to be discharged by the payment of Fifty pounds English money at 5% per annum from the 11<sup>th</sup> day of July 1782 till paid also £12 10s 2d<sup>1/2</sup> of his cost by him in this behalf expended And it is ordered that the garnisher pay the amount of his judgment and costs to the plaintiff when the money in his hands becomes due &c*

*On the motion of Robt Sheld a witness for Joseph Tofflea Esq<sup>r</sup> York it is ordered that the said Tofflea pay him one hundred pounds of £os<sup>r</sup> for 4 days all damage his bank according to Law*

*Ordered that the Court be adjourned till Court on 3<sup>rd</sup> inst
