The persons appointed to make partition & division of the slaves wherof John Pope died seized & disposed of, between the parties in this suit, this day made their report in these words " Pursuant to the within order We the subscribers have made division of the slaves within mention'd as follows Viz. Henson Pope to have negro Jenny. John Pope to have negro Selah, Sarah Pope to have negro Charlotte - Henson Pope to pay Sarah Pope four pounds three shillings four pence also Henson Pope to pay in the negroes &c Given under our hands this 8th day of July 1784 "

Signed Thomas Edmunds & Richard Blaw. - Whereupon the court order & direct that the report be the decree of this court and final between the parties

An inventory and appraisement of the Estate of John Cooper was this day returned and ordered to be recorded

An inventory & appraisement of the estate of John Rawlings decd was this returned & ordered to be recorded

An Indenture of bargain and sale between George Veik & Tabitha his wife & William Whitehead was proved by the oaths of Robert Pope about Day Wm Newman the witnesses thereto & continued

An Indenture of bargain & sale between Burwell Bell & Piscidia his wife of the one part and John Peters of the other part with the receipt entered there proved by the oaths of Wm Battle William Gelliam & Thomas James three of the witnesses thereto & ordered to be recorded

An inventory & appraisement of the estate of Henry Wellons decd was returned & ordered to be recorded

An Indenture of bargain and sale between Selah Martin of the one part and Joshua George of the other part was proved by the oaths of John Applewhite & John Reese three of the witnesses thereto & ordered to be recorded
