

On the motion of Jeremiah Sharp and Jos. Harris ^{attorneys} for Henry Baps against Randolph & Reese it is ordered that the said Baps pay the ^{costs} of the said of Tobacco road for one day's attendance each on this Court.

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William Harris having obtained an attachment against the estate of Nathaniel Teltz who hath privately absconded himself or so absconded that the ordinary process of the Law cannot be served upon him The Sheriff of this county now made return that he had executed the S. attachment in the hands of Sampson Etman Summoned him a garnishee This day came the plaintiff by his attorney & the S. garnishee appearing deposed that he hath sufficient in his hands of the estate of the defendant to satisfy the plaintiff's demand ^{which was due 1775 Dec 1778} Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the defendant Eleven pounds fourteen shillings and three pence ^{and interest from the 30th of October 1778 till paid} his debt by him ⁱⁿ their behalf expended And it is ordered that the S. Garnishee pay to the plaintiff out of the monies of the Defendant the above judgment ^{as soon as the debt from him becomes due}

A writing under the hand and seal of William Peterson for the Emancipation of London a negro man slave therein mentioned was presented to the Court by the S. Wm Peterson acknowledged by him & Order to be recorded

Gylvia Humphreys orphan of Richard Bluffee jr. came onto Court and chose Josiah Beck for her guardian Whereupon the said Josiah with Shadrach Lewis his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Two thousand fifty pounds for securing the said orphan & shall vndermining the Court

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow at 10 o'clock

This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendant Arthur Bird (this seat abating as to Nathan who is no inhabitant) withdrawing his former plea said that he cannot gainway the plaintiff's action on but that he doth owe the debt in the declaration mentioned Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the S. defendant the sum of £68. 2. 6 the value of the declaration mentioned and his costs by him at his suit in this behalf expended ^{as in many} But this judgment except the costs is to be discharged by the Defendant of Thirty pounds eleven shillings three pence & interest thereon from the 1st of February 1770 till payment to be computed at 6% per annum

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
