This day came the plaintiff by her attorney & the defendants being solemnly called and not appearing on the motion of the plaintiff it is considered that the conditional judgment obtained by the plaintiff against the defendants & that the defendants for their appearance be confirmed for Thirteen hundred twenty pounds (Paper currency) the debt in the declaration mentioned. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against them the sum of £1372.. and her costs by her about her suit in this behalf expended & be in money &c.

But this judgment except the costs is to be discharged by the payment of six hundred and eighty six pounds (Paper currency) with interest thereon at the rate of 5% p^a ann^o from 15th day of September 1780 till paid.

By a rule of this Court the said judgment is to be discharged in specie at the rate of depreciation established by act of Assembly to be calculated from Sep^r 1780 at the rate of one pound in specie for twenty two paper.

Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the said Defendants the sum of Seven hundred thirty one pounds fourteen shillings and her costs by her about her suit in this behalf expended & the said debt in money &c. But this judgment is to be discharged by the payment of seven hundred thirty pounds seventeen shillings with interest thereon at the rate of 5% p^a ann^o from the 15th day of September 1780 till paid. Which judgment except the costs by a rule of this Court is to be stated in specie at the rate of 72 in paper for one specie as directed by the act of Assembly.
