On the motion of the plaintiff by his attorney and by virtue of an act of Assembly in that case made and provided the defendants having had legal notice thereof execution is awarded the plaintiff against the said defendants for Twenty pounds eight shillings and seven pence half penny together with interest thereon from the 25th day of May 1784 till payment according to the condition of the bond aforesaid and for his costs by him in this behalf expended.

141th to

Howell Edmunds Esq. of Howell Edmunds deed. having obtained an attachment against the estate of Michael Harris who has privately removed himself or so absconded that the ordinary process of the law cannot be served upon him for a debt due to the said Howell Edmunds, Benjamin Blunt Gent. high sheriff of this county now made return that he had sufficient in his hands to discharge the debt and costs. Whereupon the defendant being solemnly called and not appearing to reply the said attach'd effects on the motion of the plaintiff it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant one thousand six hundred fifty nine pounds paper money which by a rule of court and according to an act of assembly in that case made and provided is to be discharged by the payment of a specie at 80 for one together with interest thereon from the 10th day of February 1781 till paid and his costs by him in this behalf expended, and it is ordered that the sheriff satisfy this judgment and costs with the money in his hands belonging to the defendant.

On the motion of Jephtha Altherton who made oath according to law administration is granted him on the estate of Timothy Thorpedeod. with the will annexed the order of the last court appointing John Simmons as administrator during the litigation being rescinded. Whereupon the said Jephtha Altherton with Elizabeth Taylor Howell Edmunds and Thomas Turner his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Ten thousand pounds for the said Jephtha's due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent and performance of his will.

Ordered that the court be adjourn'd till to morrow 10 o'clock.
