made return that he had sufficient in his hands to discharge the debt and costs  
Whereupon the defendant being solemnly called and not appearing to reply to the  
said attach'd effects on the motion of the plaintiff it is considered by the court that  
the plaintiff recover against the said defendant one thousand six hundred fifty  
nine pounds paper money which by a rule of court and according to an act of  
Assembly in that case made and provided is to be discharged by the payment of  
specie at 80 for one together with interest thereon from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of February  
1781 till paid and his costs by him in this behalf expended, and it is ordered  
that the sheriff satisfy this judgment and costs with the money in his hands  
belonging to the defendant.

estate of the said decedent and performance of his will.
