1783 till payment to be computed after the rate of 5th Cent Annuum

Ordered that the Churchwardens of the parish of Wotton parish bind out Eliza
Tempe Artis poor child in of Nanny Artis according to Law

On the motion of John Locke and for sufficient reasons appearing to the Court his
negroes Abram Suffer and Danies are exempted from the payment of taxes due

On the motion of Mary Seaborough a witness for the Commonwealth against
John Blotts and Maron Stosee it is Ordered that the S^r Stobs Maron Stosee
pay her twenty five pounds of Lib^y for one days attendance according to Law

On the motion of Sally Moore a witness for the Commonwealth against
John Blotts & Maron Stosee it is Ordered that they pay her fifty pounds
of Tobacco for two days attendance on this Court according to Law

On the motion of Samuell Kello and for sufficient reasons offered to the
Court it is Ordered that his negro Ned be exempted from payment of
Taxes Levies &c

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow 10 o'clock

done accordingly
