David Barrow one of the persons nominated ^{by the Court} & commissioned by the executive to act as a justice of the peace & justices in chancery for this county this day took the oath directed by law & qualified accordingly

Ordered that Henry Jones Simon Johnson and John Johnson or any two of them examine state and settle an account current of the estate of Charles Hatfield decd. to make report thereof to the next Court

An indenture of bargain and sale between William Wade and Elizabeth his wife of the one part and said Robert of the other part with a receipt thereon and assent were acknowledged by the said William Wade & Elizabeth his wife the being first examined as the law directs & ordered to be recorded

Joseph Reese and Mary Reese orphans of Edward Reese came into court & chose John Reese for their guardian whereupon the said John Reese with Henry Thorpe his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Two hundred pounds for the securing the said orphans estates and indemnifying the Court

The last will & testament of James Story was presented in court by Daniel Story the Ex^r thereon named and proved by the oaths of Drury Beale & John Wilton notaries thereto & ordered to be recorded And on the motion of the said Ex^r who made oath according to Law Certificate was granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security whereupon the said Daniel Story with ^{his security entered into and} acknowledged their bond in the penalty of ^{for securing the s^d} ^{for performing and of his will} the decedent's estate administering the same according to Law

Ordered that Drury Beale J^r. Drake Horrell Whittington & John Gresham any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the value of any personal estate of James Story decd. to return the appraisement to the next Court
