Ordered that Shadrach Lewis, Hardy Pope, Micajah Griffin & Joseph Mansfont or any three of them being first sworn according to Law do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Wm Joiner died & return the appraisement to the next Court

This day came the creditor the plaintiff by her attorney as the defendant Ridley in his proper person (the Court abates as to the other defendant John Scott who is no inhabitant) who confessed the plaintiffs claim the debt in the declaration mentioned to be just Therefore on the motion of the Plaintiff it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the S^d Defendant the S^d One hundred and nine pounds one shilling and his cost by him at her suit on his behalf provided to be levied of the goods & chattels of the S^d John Scott dead at the time of his death in the hands of the S^d Ridley & which shall come to his hands to be administered but the debt to be levied of the S^d goods & chattels of the S^d Thomas &c in money &c. But this judgment except the cost is to be discharged by paying Fifty four pounds ten shillings six pence with interest thereon at 5th S^d Barron from the 20th day of March 1783 till payment
