This day came the plaintiff by her attorney as the defendant Ridley in his proper person (the court abates as to the other defendant John Scott who is no inhabitant) who confessed the plaintiff's claim the debt in the declaration mentioned to be just Therefore on the motion of the plaintiff it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the S<sup>d</sup> Defendant the S<sup>d</sup> One hundred and nine pounds one shilling and his cost by him at her suit on this behalf expended to be levied of the goods & chattels of the S<sup>d</sup> John Scott dead at the time of his death in the hands of the S<sup>d</sup> Ridley & which shall come to his hands <sup>or</sup> to be administered but the cost to be levied of the S<sup>d</sup> goods & chattels of the S<sup>d</sup> Thomas & Co in money & Cost this judgment except the cost is to be discharged by paying Fifty pound pounds ten shillings six pence with interest thereon at 5<sup>th</sup> P<sup>er</sup> Centum from the 20<sup>th</sup> day of March 1788 till payment
