And it is ordered that the sheriff sell the attached property at public auction for ready money giving reasonable notice of the time & place of sale, & therewith discharge the aforesd Debt & costs & return an account of his proceedings to the next court

Buttacin Jones having obtained an attach ment against John Mealhouse who hath privately removed himself or so absconds that the ordinary process of law cannot be served upon him, for L^d 1 due to him by account. Reng^d Blunt Sheriff of this county now make return that he had executed the d^d attachment on a parcel of Corn - This day came the plaintiff & proved his demand to be just & the d^d defendant not now appearing to Replevy the attached property Therefore it is considered by the courts that the d^d Jones recover against the d^d Mealhouse the aforesd three pounds one shilling together with his costs in this behalf expended And is ordered that the sheriff pay to the plaintiff the amount of this judgment & costs out of the money remaining in his hands after first satisfying the judgment of Buttacin Jones against John Mealhouse & that he return an account of his proceedings to the next courts.
