An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of James Channell was returned and ordered to be recorded

An Indenture of bargain and sale between William Vick son of William of the ^{one} part and Burnell Vick of the other part was this day proved by the oath Newell Vick a witness thereto and having been proved at a former Court by the oaths of two other witnesses thereto is ordered to be recorded

The Last will and testament of Benjamin Deloach died was presented in Court by Samuel Kello one of the Executors therein named and proved by the oaths of Richard Bailey and Rich^d Kello of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded And on the motion of the said Samuel who made oath according to Law Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security Whereupon the said Sam^l with Rich^d Kello s^r his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of One thousand Pounds for the S^r Executors due & faithful administration on the estate of the S^d decedent & performance of his will

Ordered that Moses Philips Arthur Leem Secury Booth & Benjamin Branch or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves and personal estate of Benjamin Deloach died between the appraisement to the next Court

Ordered that the treasurer of this County pay William Ridley five pounds. One shilling for his account agt the S^r County produced & approved by the Court

Ordered that the Church wardens of the parish of St Lukes bind out John Covington Cooper to Rice Bolton Pierce according to Law & it is noted that the indentures heretofore entered into for binding out the S^r Cooper be vacated
