An Indenture of bargain and sale between Hardy Dayel and Maitha his wife of the one part and Wm Cribble of the other part with a return and receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the S^r Hardy Dayel & Maitha his wife the being first privately examined as the Law directs & ordered to be recorded

Ordered that the treasurer of this County pay Wm Cribble Two pounds for his out now produced & approved by the Court

Thomas Porter and John Porter orphans of John Porter chose Ethelred Brantley for their guardian and the court appoint the said Ethelred guardian to Benjamin Hope and Tabitha Porter orphans of the afores^d John Porter dec^d Whereupon the said Ethelred Brantley with John Powell his security entered into back now lodged their bond in the penalty of Five hundred pounds for securing the estate of the S^r Orphans and indemnifying the Court

Ordered that the Treasurer pay Arthur Boykin Three pounds, eighteen shillings for repairing Soarock bridge

On the motion of John Raley husband of the late Ann Allen dec^d to revoke the letters of administration on the said Ann formerly granted to Rich^d Raley on hearing the parties the motion is dismissed

An Inventory of the estate of John Withington was returned & ordered to be recorded

Tabitha Matthews came into court and chose Jacob Bailey for her guardian Whereupon the said Jacob with John Cook his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five hundred pounds for securing the orphans estate and indemnifying the Court

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the next in course
