An Indenture of bargain and sale between Hady Dayel and Maitha his wife of the one part and Wm Cichloco of the other part with a memorandum receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the S^d Hady Dayel & Maitha his wife the being first privately examined as the Law directs & ordered to be recorded

Ordered that the treasurer of this county pay Wm Cichloco Two pounds for his out now produced & approved by the Court

Thomas Porter and John Porter orphans of John Porter chose Etheldred Brantly for their guardian and the court appointed the said Etheldred guardian to Benjamin Depe and Tabitha Porter orphans of the afores^d John Porter died Whereupon the said Etheldred Brantly with John Powell his security entered into back now lodged their bond in the penalty of Five hundred pounds for securing the estate of the S^d Orphans and indemnifying the Court

Tabitha Halford came into court and chose Jacob Bailey for her guardian Whereupon the said Jacob with John Cook his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five hundred pounds for securing the orphans estate and indemnifying the Court

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the next in course
