

Upon the petition of Jeremiah Dore Esq: &c of Newt Dore decd. against Anthony Sweet and Joshua Harris for two pounds fifteen shillings due by note. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendant having been duly summoned and served with a copy of the petition and not appearing on the motion of the plaintiff it is considered by the court that he recover against Joshua Harris two pounds fifteen shillings and 90th his costs by him in this behalf expended. and the defendant Anthony Sweet being released 8/6th no inhabitant it is ordered that this petition abate as to him. That this judgment except the costs is to be discharged by the payment of one pound seven shillings and six pence with interest thereon to be computed after the rate of five per centum per annum from the 25th day of December 1776 till paid.

This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendants having 8/7/6th been duly summoned and served with a copy of the petition and not appearing on the motion of the plaintiff it is considered by the court that he recover against the defendants three hundred sixty four pounds of tobacco and his costs by him in this behalf expended.

Ordered that Elias Horring and David Barrows in conjunction with persons affiant by the court of Isle of Wight sett the repairing of Blackwater bridge to the lowest under-taker and make report thereof to this court.

Richard Kirk Petif. On a bond given to relieve the effects of the said toller taken by virtue of a writ of fieri facias issuing on a judgment obtained by the Petif. against the said toller as security for Arthur Boykin & Simon Boykin Dfts. Stephen Simmell.

On the motion of the plaintiff by his attorney and by virtue of an act of assembly in that case made and provided the defendants having had legal notice hereof judgment is awarded the plaintiff for twenty three pounds eight shillings and two pence half penny with interest thereon to be computed after the rate of five per centum per annum from the 4th day of November 1784 till paid against the defendants according to the condition of the bond aforesaid and for his costs by him in this behalf expended.

Ordered that the court be adjourned till court in course.
