Ordered that process issue against the several persons this day presented by the Grand Jury
to cause them to appear at the next court and answer the prosecution entered against them re-
spectively

A deed of gift from William Boone to Temperance Taylor was proved by the oaths
of Ethelinda Taylor and John Taylor the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

The last will and testament of Benjamin Cawm dead. was presented in court by John Cobb
and Brown Cobb the executors thereto named, proved by the oaths of Benjamin Griffin and
Michael Cobb two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the
said executors who made oath according to law certificate is granted them for obtaining a
probate thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said John Cobb and Brown
Cobb with Samuel Tello their security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the
penalty of two thousand pounds for the said executors due and faithfull administration on
the State of their testator and performance of his will.

Ordered that William Peiry, Rue B. Peirce, John R. Pond and Richard Pond or any
three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in
current money the slaves and personal estate of Benjamin Cawm dead and return the
appraisement to the next court.

An indenture of bargain and sale between John Johnson of the one part and Arthur Birning
of the other part and the receipt thereon offered were proved by the oaths James Johnson,
Joseph Vaper and Tabitha Vaper the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

A deed of trust and mortgage from Stephen and John Summerell to Jacob Turner and
Henry Branch was proved by the oaths of Jasper Summerell and John Powell two of the
witnesses thereto and continuing for further proof.

An indenture of bargain and sale between Mathews Boykin of the one part and John
Boykin of the other part was proved by the oaths of John Clayton, Jacob Turner and Daniel
Boykin the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

Sophia Green orphan of John Green dead. came into court and chose Samuel Green her
guardian. Whereupon the said Samuel Green with John Kirby his security entered into and
acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five hundred pounds for the said Samuel's rea-
sing the said orphans estate and insuring the court.

An indenture of bargain and sale between Samuel Sandiford and Nancy his wife of
the one part and Samuel Rade the younger of the other part was acknowledged by the
said Samuel Sandiford and Nancy his wife she being first privately examined as the law
directs and ordered to be recorded.

In the motion of Benjamin Blunt constable high sheriff of this county Benjamin Blunt
was made his undersheriff.

Benjamin Blunt constable produced a commission to the court from his excellency the Governor
to be county lieutenant of the militia of this county and took the oath prescribed by law.

An indenture of bargain and sale between Joseph Vaper and Tabitha his wife of the one part
and Jep Gardner of the other part was acknowledged by the said Joseph Vaper and Tabitha
his wife she being first privately examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of bargain and sale between Jep Watson of the one part and Thomas Clements
of the other part was acknowledged by the said Jep Watson and ordered to be recorded.

William Newsum orphan of David Newsum dead. came into court and chose Randolph
Newsum his guardian. Whereupon the said Randolph Newsum with John Simmons his secu-
rity entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Ten thousand pounds for the
said Randolph's securing the said orphan's estate and insuring the court.

An indenture of feoffment between Jacob Turner of the one part and John Martin of the
other part with a memorandum affixing of seal thereon orders were acknowledged by
the said Jacob Turner and ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that Jordan Denson and Arthur Boykin examine state and settle an account and
of the estate of Moses Johnson dead and make report thereof to this court.
