But this judgment except the costs is to be discharged by the payment of Sixty five pounds current money together with interest thereon after the rate of 5^p Centum Per Annum from the 14th February 1778 till payment. By a rule of this Court and according to an act of Assembly in that case made & provided this judgment is to be discharged in specie at the rate of One pound specie for every five pounds paper.

But this judgment except the costs is to be discharged by the payment of One thousand & twenty five pounds current money with interest thereon after the rate of 5^p Centum Per Annum from the 5th day of October 1780 till payment — Which by a rule of this Court and according to an act of Assembly is to be discharged except the costs at the rate of seventy three pounds in paper for one in specie.
