A deed of mortgage from Stephen Summerville and John Summerville to Jacob Turner and Henry Brinch was proved by the oath of Jeremiah Summerville one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved by the oaths of two other witnesses is ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of bargain and sale between Henry John Burgess and Sarah his wife of the one part and Joseph Washington of the other part who, proved by the oaths of John Judkins, William Washington and George Washington the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

John Wright Plaintiff? In Debt
against Jeremiah Tyler Dft.

Edmund Tyler comes into court and undertakes for the defendant that in case he is cast in this suit he shall pay and satisfy the condemnation of this court or render his body to prison in discharge thereof or that he the said Edmund will do it for him, Whereupon the said defendant by his attorney, prayd and has leave to impanel till the next court.

Upon the petition of John Wright against Jeremiah Tyler for Three pounds eighteen shillings and interest due by order. This day came the plaintiff by Richard Hello his attorney and the defendant having been duly summoned and not appearing on the motion of the plaintiff it is considered by the court that he recover against the defendant Three pounds eighteen shillings together with interest thereon to be computed after the rate of five per centum annuum from the 11th day of Novbr. 1784 till payment and his costs by him in this behalf expended. Mem° The plaintiff agrees to stay execution of this judgment two months from this date.

An indenture of bargain and sale between William Holliman and Rebecca his wife of the one part and James Newson of the other part was acknowledged by the said William Holliman and Rebecca his wife, she being first privately examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.
