

On the motion of Amos Jeyner a witness for Robert Washington against William Whitehead executor &c of Edmund Day dead. it is ordered that the said Robert Washington pay him four hundred pounds of tobacco for sixteen days attendance on this court according to law.

On the motion of Patty Pike a witness for Robert Washington against William Whitehead executor &c of Edmund Day dead. it is ordered that the said Robert Washington pay her three hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco for fourteen days attendance on this court according to law.

On the motion of Evans Pike a witness for Robert Washington against William Whitehead executor &c of Edmund Day dead. it is ordered that the said Robert Washington pay him seventy five pounds of tobacco for three days attendance on this court according to law.

The last will and testament of Samuel Vick dead. was presented in court by Shadrach Vick and Nathan English the executors therein named, proved by the oaths of Drury Beale and Edmund Ashley the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said executors who made oath according to law certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Shadrach Vick and Nathan English with Holladay Acwill their security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five hundred pounds for the said executors due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent and performance of his will.

Ordered that Jeremiah Drake, Drury Beale, William Thomas and John Rochelle or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves (if any) and personal estate of Samuel Vick dead. and return the appraisement to the next court.

An indenture of settlement between Joshua Westbrooke of the one part and Hannah Westbrooke of the other part with the memorandum of livery of seisin and the receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Joshua Westbrooke and ordered to be recorded.

Rachel Drenvit orphan of William Drenvit dead. came into court and chose John Mundell jr. for her guardian. Whereupon the said John Mundell jr. with John Bland his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of two hundred & fifty pounds for the said John's securing the estate of the said Rachel and indemnifying the court.

An indenture of bargain and sale between Trial Bailey and Martha his wife of the one part and Jonathan Loker of the other part was acknowledged by the said Trial Bailey and Martha his wife she being first privately examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Britain Pike a witness for William Whitehead executor &c of Edmund Day dead. at the suit of Robert Washington in an action on the case it is ordered that the said William Whitehead pay him seven hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco for thirty days attendance on this court according to law.
