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Upon the presentment of the grand jury, against William Westra for profanely swearing
at 16th day of May last on the ground. This day came the attorney for the com-
monwealth and the said William Westra having been duly summoned and not appearing
96th or offering any thing in his defence it is considered by the court that the said William Westra
87/6 make his fine with this our commonwealth by the payment of five shillings to the church-
wardens of the parish of Rottenway according to an act of assembly in that case made &
provided, and that he also pay the costs of this prosecution

The presentment of the grand jury, against Drury Harris surveyor of the road from So-
lomon Harrisons to John Mirells for not keeping the same in order is ordered to be
dismissed

Upon the presentment of the grand jury against Joshua Thorpe for profane swearing at Jo-
seph Gurley's on the 28th day of April last. This day came the attorney for the common-
96th wealth and the said Joshua Thorpe having been duly summoned and not appearing or
87/6 offering any thing in his defence it is considered by the court that the said Joshua Thorpe
make his fine with this our commonwealth by the payment of five shillings to the church-
wardens of the parish of Rottenway according to an act of assembly in that case made and
provided and that he also pay the costs of this prosecution

The court being informed by John Carr Starkey that Lawrence Joiner hath lately beaten
and wounded his wife and it being suggested that he is insane it is ordered that the said
John Carr Starkey take the said Lawrence Joiner and produce him before the court to
morrow.

On the motion of Hannah Westrooke who made it appear to the satisfaction of the court
that she hath had two negroes too many listed it is ordered that the tax on the same be remitted
Flandy Harris and Martha Thorpe £20s. 4^c of John Thorpe deed. Pltf^s ? In Debt
against Thomas Bap^s and Nathaniel Nonsum Dfts

This day, came as well the plaintiffs by their attorney as the defendant Tho-
mas Bap^s in his proper person who confess'd the plaintiff's action for Eighteen pounds two
161th to 8/16th shillings the debt in the declaration mentioned to be just. Therefore it is considered by the
court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant Eighteen pounds two shil-
lings and their costs by them about their suit in this behalf expended & the said defend-
ant in mercy &c. and the defendant Nathaniel Nonsum being return'd no inhabitant it
is ordered that this suit abate as to him.

But this judgment except the costs is to be discharged by the payment
of Nine pounds one shilling & sixpence together with interest thereon to be computed after the
rate of five per centum per annum from the 25th day of December 1782 till payment.
Mem^d The plaintiffs agree in court to stay execution of this judgment three months from
this date.

The petition of William Blunt and John Blunt £20s. 4^c of William Byrnes deed
against Thomas Turner a doctor &c of William Turner deed, for one pound fourteen shillings
and four pence is ordered to be dismissed at the defendants costs.

Samuel Blake, having obtain'd an attachment against the estate of Thomas Blake who
