Whereupon the said William Gryrick and Randolph Newsum with Solomon Deleach and Etheldred Taylor their subscribers entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Threethousand pounds for the said executors due and faithfully administrated on the estate of the said defendant and performance of his will.
- Ordered that Thomas Turner, John Barrow, William Ridley and Arthur Applewhite or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves (if any) and personal estate of Jeremiah Drew decd. and return the appraisement to the next court.
- An indenture of bargain and sale between Samuel Rade jun^r of the one part and Hardy Doyell of the other part and the receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Samuel Rade jun^r and ordered to be recorded.
