This cause was this day heard on the plea of the plaintiffs, the answer of the defendants, the several depositions and exhibits filed therein by the arguments of counsel ~~on~~ ⁱⁿ consideration whereof it is decreed & ordered that the Defendants pay to the plaintiffs out of the estate of their testator in their hands to be administered the sum of ~~Twenty~~ ^{Thirty} two pounds ten shillings in lieu of all demands against the testator of these defendants & that they also pay to the plaintiffs their costs by them in this behalf expended.

On the motion of Lewis Bowen a witness for John Underwood against ~~Abraham Underwood~~ ^{Abraham Underwood} it is decreed that the said John Underwood pay him Three hundred pounds of ~~Tobacco~~ ^{Tobacco} for 12 days attendance on this Court according to Law

On the motion of Thomas Dove a witness for Joshua Whitney against ~~Charles Jones~~ ^{Charles Jones} it is ordered that the said Whitney pay him 325 lbs of Tobacco for fifteen days attendance on this Court according to Law

This day came ~~several~~ ^{several} the plaintiffs by his attorney as the Defendant in his proper person who ~~defending~~ ^{defending} his former plea saith that he cannot gainsay the plaintiffs action nor but that he owes the Debt in the declaration mentioned in manner & form as the plaintiffs aver him both Complaind Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiffs recover against the said Defendant Five hundred and fifty two pounds ten shillings & pence the debt in the declaration mentioned & his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended & the said Defendant in many &c

But this judgment except the Debt is to be discharged by the payment of Two hundred & seventy six pounds five shillings with interest thereon from the 11th May 1782 till payment first deducting ^{payments} the payments following to wit Seventy pounds twelve shillings & six pence made the 1st June 1782. — One hundred and twenty three pounds seventeen shillings & six pence made the 23rd day of December 1782 & forty four pounds on the 4th day of Jan^y 1783 with interest on each from the several dates. But on the motion of the defendant by his attorney for an injunction subpoena directed to the plaintiffs and all others concerned for stay of all further proceedings upon this judgment until the same is heard in equity and the Court being fully satisfied with the matter of equity the same is granted him on his giving bond and security at the next Court.
