This cause was this day heard on the behalf of the plaintiffs,

the answer of the defendants, the several depositions and exhibits filed herein by
the arguments of counsel. On consideration whereof it is decreed by Order that the
Defendants pay to the plaintiffs out of the estate of their testator in their hands
to be administered the sum of Thirty two pounds ten shillings in lieu of all demands
against the testator of these defendants & that they also pay to the plaintiffs their costs
by them on this behalf expended.

On the motion of Lewis Brown a witness for John Underwood against John Under-
wood it is ordered that the said John Underwood pay him Three hundred pounds of tobacco
for 12 days attendance on this court according to Law.

On the motion of Thomas Love a witness for Joshua Whitney against Matthew Jones
it is ordered that the said Whitney pay him 325 lbs of tobacco for thirteen days attendance
on this court according to Law.

In Debt

This day came seimus the plaintiff
by his attorney as the defendant in his proper person who saith having his
former plea saith that he cannot gainsay the plaintiffs action nor but that he owes
the debt in the declaration mentioned in manner & form as the plaintiff against him hath
complained. Therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against
the said defendant Fifte hundred and fifty two pounds ten shillings & pence
the debt in the declaration mentioned & his costs by him about his suit in his behalf
expended & the said defendant in money to be paid to the plaintiff.

But this judgment

except the last is to be discharged by the payment of Two hundred & seven
six pounds five shillings with interest thereon from the 11th May 1782 till
payment first deducting the payments following to wit Seventy pounds
twelve shillings & six pence made the 1st June 1782. — One hundred and
twenty three pounds seventeen shillings & six pence made the 28th day of
December 1782 & forty four pounds on the 4th day of Jan: 1783 with
interest on each from the several dates. — But on the motion of the defendant by

his attorney for an injunction subpoena directed to the plaintiff and all others concerned for
stay of all further proceedings upon this judgment until the same is heard in equity and
the court being fully satisfied with the matter of equity the same is granted him, on his
giving bond and security at the next court.
