An indenture of bargain and sale between David Jones and Martha his wife of the one part and Childred Taylor of the other part was acknowledged by the said David Jones and Martha his wife she being first privately examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

Jesse Carrell who was at July court last chosen guardian to Thomas Carrell orphan of Thomas Carrell this day with Hartwell Bailey his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Two hundred pounds for securing the said orphan's estate and indemnifying this court.

An indenture of bargain and sale between Elisha L. Ballard of the one part and John Lawrence of the other part was acknowledged by the said Elisha L. Ballard and ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that the treasurer of this county, pay Samuel Bailey this county's proportion of 914 feet of plank at 2/8 hundred furnished for Pottor's bridge in 1782, 1781 & 1783 and account thereof with the court.

The last will and testament of John Bryant dead, was presented in court by John Bryant the executor therein named, proved by the oaths of Benjamin Beale and William Fowler the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said executor who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said John Bryant with Joseph Scott jun<sup>r</sup> his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five hundred pounds for the due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent and performance of his will.

Ordered that William Edwards, William Williams, Richard Beale and Jonas Edwards or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of John Bryant dead, and return the appraisement to the next court.
