his wife Forty one pounds thirteen shillings and four pence, with interest thereon from
12th June 1780 till paid, to Elizabeth Lundy now the wife of Jabez Morris Forty one
83/16. pounds thirteen shillings and four pence with interest thereon from August 1783
the time of their intermarriage and to the other children, Byrd Lundy, Joshua
Lundy, James Lundy and Edwin Lundy the sum of Forty one pounds thirteen
shillings and four pence cash without interest, and that they also pay unto the
complainants their costs by them about their suit in this behalf expended.
