jamin Edwards, Lemuel Hart and John Johnson as Ensigns, and severally qua-
ried to their respective commissions according to law.

An instrument of writing under the hand and seal of John Johnson emancipating
and setting free a certain negro woman named Millie was acknowledged by the
said John Johnson and ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that Robert Bailey and Howell Edmunds examine, state and settle an ac-
count current of the estate of John Satter deed and make report thereof to this court.
The account current of the estate of John Satter deed was reported by the persons appoint-
ed to examine, state and settle the same and ordered to be recorded.

A writing said to be the last will and testament of Jacob Johnson deed, being produced
to the first court which had been defaced and rendered wholly unintelligible and it being sug-
gested to the court that it was done by Benjamin Johnson the heir at law who was summon-
ed to answer the same and he not now appearing, a copy of the said will was produced and
Thomas Edmunds and Sarah Johnson, who were two of the witnesses to the original, made
oath that the said copy is as nearly verbatim from the original as they can recollect &
that the distribution of the estate was the same in the original as in the said copy, on con-
sideration whereof the said copy is ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of bargain and sale between John Commons jun^r and Lucy his wife of the one
part and Edwin Commons of the other part was acknowledged by the said John Commons Jr
and Lucy his wife she being first privily examined as the law directs and ordered to be re-
