Drake, Council Johnson, Pinckney Doggett being solemnly called and not appearing, and the attachment awarded the plaintiff at the last court against the estates of the defendants John Beaton and Moses Joiner being returned executed on a porter dish from Joiner and two wedding hoes from Beaton, and they not now appearing to reply, the same, it is ordered that the judgment obtained at the last court against the defendant Ethelred Drake and Timothy Drake security for his appearance, Council Johnson and Hardy Johnson security for his appearance and Moses Joiner be confirmed for Twenty six pounds Eight shillings current money of Virginia the debt in the declaration mentioned. Therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the defendants and their securities for their appearance the aforesaid sum of Twenty six pounds eight shillings and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended and the said defendants in mercy &c. And the defendant Britain former being returned no inhabitant it is ordered that this suit abate as to him; the plaintiff in court also agrees to release the attache'd effects of the defendants John Beaton and Moses Joiner. But this judgment except the costs is to be discharged by the payment of Thirteen pounds four shillings with interest thereon to be compensated after the rate of five per centum per annum from the 14th day of May 1783 till paid.
