for his appearance and Moses Joiner be confirmed for Twenty six pounds Eight
shillings current money of England the debt in the declaration mentioned Therefore
it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the defendants and
their securities for their appearance the aforesaid sum of Twenty six pounds eight
shillings and his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended and the said
defendants in mercy &c. And the defendant Brittain Joiner being returned no inha-
bitant it is ordered that this suit abate as to him, the plaintiff in court also agree
