

Ordered that John Blaud, Jesse Cooper, Joshua Davis and James Woodcock or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Samuel Westbrook dead and return the appraisement to the next court.

The last will and testament of John Westbrook dead was presented in court by Lucy Westbrook the executrix therein named, proved by the oaths of Daniel Porter and Elizabeth Moore two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motions of the said executrix (liberty being reserved for the executors to qualify) who made oath according to law certificate is granted her for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Lucy Westbrook with Burrell Westbrook her co-surety entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Three thousand pounds for the said Lucy's due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent and performance of his will.

Ordered that John Roges, James Lundy, William Blaud and Benjamin-Clifton or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of John Westbrook dead and return the appraisement to the next court.

An indenture of bargain and sale between John Joy and Mary his wife of the one part and Benjamin Adams of the other part was acknowledged by the said John Joy and Mary his wife she being first privily examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

An Inventory of the estate of Joseph Lancaster deceased was returned and ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of bargain and sale between Charles Fowler of the one part and James Barnes of the other part with the receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Charles Fowler and ordered to be recorded.

The last will and testament of Natham Harris dead was presented in court, proved by the oaths of John Kindred, Natham Bryant and Cordal Bynum the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. the executors therein named having taken allowed them to qualify thereto.

Agreeable to the last will and testament of Byrd Lundy decd. the court appoints John Murick, John Barrow and Joshua Hooper to divide the slaves belonging to the estate of the said Byrd Lundy between the legatees, and it is ordered that they make report thereof to this court.

An indenture of bargain and sale between Arthur Barrow of the one part and John Benion of the other part was proved by the oath of David Denson one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved by the oaths of the two other witnesses is ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of bargain and sale between James Garity son^r and Elizabeth his wife of the one part and James Vark son^r of the other part was proved by the oaths of John Cornwell and John Ingram two of the witnesses thereto and continued for further proof.

Ordered that William Nugbaust, John Clayton and Gaswell Cooke or any two of them in conjunction with persons appointed by the court of Sale of Wight county lett the repair of broad water bridges to the lowest undertaker and make report thereof to this court.

Ordered that Mizajah Holliman, Richard Kells and Samuel Kells or any two of them lett the repairs of sea coast bridges near the coast to the lowest undertaker and make report thereof to this court.
