

Ordered that Elias Herring, David Barrow and Edmund Tyler or any two of them in conjunction with persons appointed by the court of Isle of Wight county, lett the re-building of black water bridge to the lowest undertaker and make report thereof to this court and that they also agree with some person to provide a flat for the purpose of carrying the inhabitants of Southampton and Isle of Wight from one county to the other.

Ordered that the treasurer of this county pay Thomas Brock Fifteen pounds nineteen shillings and eleven pence for the rebuilding of the upper seacock bridge the persons appointed to view the same having reported that it was completed according to agreement, and account thereof with the court.

Jacob Barnes and Joseph Britt are appointed inspectors of pork, beef, tar and turpentine in this county and qualified accordingly.

On the motion of William Boykin who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of William Williamson deceased giving security. Whereupon the said William Boykin with Edmund Tyler his security entered into and acknowledged their bond on the penalty of Two thousand pounds for the said William's due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent.

Ordered that John Clayton, Samuel Hobson, Arthur Boykin and William Appleton or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves [if any] and personal estate of William Williamson decd. and return the appraisement to the next court.

An indenture of bargain and sale between Moses Booth and Sarah his wife of the one part and Beverley Booth of the other part and the receipt thereon endors'd were acknowledged by the said Moses Booth and Sarah his wife she being first privily examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

An account current of the estate of Edward Reese decd. was reported by the persons appointed to examine, state and settle the same and ordered to be recorded.

An account current of the estate of Thomas Lantford decd. was reported by the persons appointed to examine, state and settle the same and ordered to be recorded.
