But this judgment except the costs is to be discharged by the payment one pound sixteen shillings with interest thereon from June 25<sup>th</sup> 1785 till paid.

But this judgment except the costs is to be discharged by the payment of one pound eleven shillings and three pence with interest thereon from the 15<sup>th</sup> day of October 1784 till paid.
