

out of that he be in custody of the sheriff of this county until he finds such security, Whereupon the said Crafford with Jacob Westbrook his security acknowledged themselves bound to the churchwardens of the parish of Stoke in the sum of Twenty five pounds each of their respective goods & chattels to be found & to the s<sup>r</sup> Churchwardens rendered Yet upon this condition that if the said Crafford shall well & truly maintain & support the said bastard Child in all things necessary until in the opinion of the churchwardens it shall arrive to a sufficient age to be bound out then this obligation to be void.

Upon the petition of Thomas Edmunds agst Isham Atkinson son of Sand Atkinson for three pounds, due by note whereinon this day came, to wit, the s<sup>r</sup> Thomas & the s<sup>r</sup> Isham who confessed the plaintif's demand to be just Therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintif recover against him the afores<sup>d</sup> Three pounds with interest thereon from the 13<sup>th</sup> of March 1785 till payment of this sum by him in this behalf expended to the lessees of the goods & chattels of Sand Atkinson in the hands of the s<sup>r</sup> Isham to be administered as much he hath if not the cost to be made of the proper goods & chattels of the s<sup>r</sup> Edmunds
